

CHARACTER EDUCATION QUESTIONS

Here are 15 important character traits along with 3 discussion questions for each trait:

1. Kindness

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. Can you think of a time when someone was kind to you? How did it make you feel?
2. What are some small things you can do to show kindness to others?
3. Why do you think it's important to be kind, even when others are not?

2. Honesty

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. Why is telling the truth sometimes hard, even when you know it's the right thing?
2. How do you feel when someone lies to you? How does honesty help build trust?
3. Can you think of a time when telling the truth helped you or someone else?

3. Responsibility

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What does being responsible mean to you? Can you give an example?
2. How do you take responsibility for your actions at school or at home?
3. How does being responsible help others around you?

4. Respect

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What are some ways to show respect to others, even if you don't agree with them?
2. How can you show respect for your own belongings and others' things?
3. Why is it important to treat others with respect, no matter their age or background?

5. Courage

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. Can you think of a time when you had to be brave? How did it make you feel?
2. What's the difference between being scared and showing courage?
3. Why do you think courage is important in challenging situations?

6. Patience

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. How do you feel when you have to wait for something you really want?
2. What are some ways you can practice being patient with others?
3. Why is it hard to be patient sometimes, and how can we improve?

7. Empathy

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What does it mean to understand how someone else is feeling?
2. How can you show empathy when a friend is upset?
3. Why is empathy important for making friends and helping others?

8. Fairness

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What do you think is the most important part of being fair?
2. How do you handle situations when something feels unfair?
3. Why is it important to treat everyone fairly, even when you have different opinions?

9. Gratitude

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What is something you're grateful for today?
2. How can you show appreciation to someone who has done something nice for you?
3. Why is it good to practice gratitude regularly?

10. Perseverance

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What's something you didn't give up on, even when it was hard?
2. How do you keep going when things get tough?
3. Why do you think persevering is important in reaching your goals?

11. Generosity

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What are some ways you can be generous to others, even if you don't have a lot to give?
2. How does it feel when you share with others?
3. Why is it important to be generous, even if you don't get anything in return?

12. Self-Control

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. Can you think of a time when you had to use self-control? What happened?
2. How do you resist temptation when you really want something?
3. Why do you think self-control is important in making good decisions?

13. Creativity

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. What's something creative you've made or done recently?
2. How does being creative help solve problems or express yourself?
3. Why is it important to allow yourself to be creative?

14. Teamwork

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. How can you work with others to reach a goal as a team?
2. What's the best part about working in a team? What's the hardest?
3. How does teamwork help you learn from others?

15. Trustworthiness

- **Discussion Questions:**

1. Why is it important to trust others and for them to trust you?
2. How can you show that you are trustworthy?
3. What happens if someone breaks your trust? How can trust be rebuilt?
